1           REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: So now we just  
2 have to draw eight mail batches. So there's not going  
3 to be a thousandths digit. The highest hundredths digit  
4 we can draw is seven. We can close up the thousands,  
5 the hundreds. We can pull the eight and the nine.

6           PAT GRACIAN: These are mail-in ballots?

7           REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: We are drawing  
8 numbers between 1 and 730.

9           SPEAKER 1: So you have 730 billets of mail  
10 ballots.

11          REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE: Pardon?

12          SPEAKER 1: You have 730 billets of mail  
13 ballots.

14          REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: We call them  
15 batches or dets. It's roughly representative --

16          RAY LUTZ: Does that include the ones that  
17 came in on election day?

18          REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: Definitely not.

19          REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 2: Yes. Excuse me.  
20 Up to election day.

21          RAY LUTZ: So you are not one percent of the  
22 total, only one percent of the ones you have received so  
23 far.

24          REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: Yes.

25          RAY LUTZ: So it's less than one percent of

2           REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: I'd have to look

3 at the code again. I think it's one percent of we have  
4 on election day.

5 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 2: On election day.

6 PAT GRACIAN: So there's 730 batches. How  
7 many --

8 RAY LUTZ: No. You have them, but you're just  
9 saying you haven't validated them yet, so you don't know  
10 if you have them; is that right?

11 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: Right.

12 RAY LUTZ: But have you counted all the  
13 mail-in ballots that you received at this point?

14 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: There's two ways  
15 to look at that. Counted as in we have it included in  
16 the tally yet. They have been -- because they haven't  
17 been opened yet.

18 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 2: They haven't been  
19 validated for the count.

20 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: We have an  
21 estimate of how many we have, but we have to go through  
22 and validate signature check before we can actually scan  
23 them.

24 RAY LUTZ: So if you were being, really call  
25 it conservative, the 1 percent would be -- you would

1 include more batches because you have to include one  
2 percent of the entire total.

3 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: We'd have to wait  
4 to know.

5 RAY LUTZ: Or you can say worse case, the

6 number of batches that we have would include all of  
7 them?

8 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: We could. That's  
9 not how the procedures are run.

10 RAY LUTZ: Okay. So you are taking the -- you  
11 are trying to get as few --

12 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 2: Find the  
13 procedure. That might be the first step.

14 PAT GRACIAN: How many ballots are per batch?

15 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: There's about  
16 400. Just the size of the box.

17 PAT GRACIAN: Approximately 400 per batch.

18 RAY LUTZ: It doesn't say anything in here  
19 that I see about the ballots coming in.

20 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: The remaining  
21 contents. Remember we drew --

22 RAY LUTZ: It doesn't really apply -- this  
23 procedure here doesn't apply to the vote by mail  
24 ballots. It doesn't talk about that.

25 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: No.

1 RAY LUTZ: So if you have the 280,000 ballots  
2 that are still uncounted according to your website, is  
3 that the estimate of how many, if they were all  
4 validated, the number coming in?

5 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: Yes.

6 RAY LUTZ: Okay. How many do you think --  
7 would be in this here, but I would have to take some  
8 time to total it up, how many vote by mail ballots

9 are -- actually, wait. According to this, these numbers  
10 right here, the number that you're going to pull, that's  
11 based on having something like 730 mail-in batches it  
12 says, right?

13 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: Right.

14 RAY LUTZ: How many approximately in each  
15 batch?

16 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: About 400.

17 RAY LUTZ: Okay. So we have 730 times 400.  
18 Here we go.

19 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 2: So what we are  
20 going to do, we'll go ahead and do this as we currently  
21 have it. If there needs to be further conversation  
22 about how we --

23 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: Procedures, we  
24 will have further conversation.

25 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 2: We will go

1 forward right now, go ahead picking as we --

2 RAY LUTZ: That may be right. When I  
3 multiply by 730, I get 292,000.

4 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 2: Right.

5 RAY LUTZ: That's not been counted yet. Maybe  
6 that include these. That would make sense. You're  
7 doing a great job. I thought I was going to catch you.

8 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 2: That might be the  
9 nicest thing you ever said.

10 RAY LUTZ: I thought I was going to catch you.

11 PAT GRACIAN: Mail-in ballots. What about the

12 provisionals? Does include that include provisionals?

13 RAY LUTZ: No. It may be a different number.

14 In other words, they may have to choose twice as many as  
15 they think on there or they are doing it right.

16 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 2: What we are going  
17 to do is move forward with our procedure as we have it  
18 now. We're certainly open and welcome to talking after  
19 this about modifications.

20 RAY LUTZ: Okay.

21 SPEAKER 1: As far as you know, the mail-in  
22 ballots that were delivered on election day are not  
23 included in the billets that you are counting for this  
24 random re-count?

25 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: Say that again.

1 SPEAKER 1: As far as you know -- as far as  
2 you know, the mail-in ballots that were delivered to the  
3 polls on election day are not included in the billets  
4 that are going to be included in this manual one percent  
5 recount.

6 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: Correct, because  
7 we still have to signature-check all those and make sure  
8 they're eligible to be counted, but we are going to pull  
9 these out as soon as we select which batches we are  
10 going to pick, I'm going to take this down to technical  
11 services and he is going to pull these out for us to  
12 count and the ones came in yesterday haven't been opened  
13 or scanned

14 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 2: They are not

15 processed at all.

16 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: So we couldn't  
17 give them to count.

18 RAY LUTZ: So actually, I take that back. I  
19 think the number that the should be 16 instead of eight,  
20 if you are going to include the same number in each the  
21 batch because that is an arbitrary number because you  
22 should be sampling more of those than you are, because  
23 you are not sampling one percent of the total number.

24 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 2: Up until the  
25 election day. So it is a timing. But again, that is a

1 conversation for you guys to have not with the people in  
2 this room.

3 SPEAKER 1: We will talk to Michael Vu or  
4 somebody in charge of the procedure.

5 RAY LUTZ: I think we're clear about the fact  
6 that what we're doing right now doesn't include all of  
7 the -- what you just mentioned, all of what was brought  
8 in election day.

9 SPEAKER 1: It doesn't include provisional  
10 ballots on election day, nor does it include the mail-in  
11 ballots on election day.

12 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 2: Just to be clear,  
13 we're not trying count votes cast. We are trying to  
14 make sure that what we have is an actual match manually  
15 to what the machine counted. And additionally we will,  
16 same thing with the mail ballots, find any context that  
17 are not included in these numbers and we will also have

18 to count those.

19 SPEAKER 1: Right. We are only checking the  
20 accuracy of the machines instead of counting the  
21 ballots.

22 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 2: Correct. Not  
23 counting --

24 SPEAKER 1: I totally agree and understand  
25 that. It's just that with leaving out specific subsets

1 of the total, you end up with the potential, especially  
2 because those subsets would tend to swing one way or the  
3 other, that your machine may not be catching certain  
4 types of voting accurately.

5 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 2: I totally hear  
6 what you're saying.

7 RAY LUTZ: And since state law does say it's  
8 one percent, if you're not doing one percent, you're not  
9 really following the law.

10 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 2: So again, we will  
11 move forward with how we are currently --

12 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 1: The code says one  
13 percent of precinct. It doesn't speak to the mail  
14 ballots.

15 RAY LUTZ: That -- it doesn't talk about  
16 mail-in ballots.

17 REGISTRAR REPRESENTATIVE 2: This is purely  
18 our procedure for what we're doing here.

19 RAY LUTZ: I know. We will have to raise  
20 those issues separately?
